Continuous Professional Development (CPD) Training Programme

- A 30-hour CPD Training Programme for school educators and counsellors.
- Aims to empower educators to create safe and supportive environments for consent discussions.

Toolkit of Drama and Storytelling Resources:

- Innovative materials for teaching consent through creative approaches.
- Practical activities, lesson plans, and guidance on using drama and storytelling techniques to talk about consent.
