Teachers from each partner country were hosted by DANTE in Rijeka, Croatia, from January 28th to 30th for training on implementing ACT4CONSENT resources in their classrooms. They explored creative approaches, such as storytelling and drama, to teach consent while also engaging in self-care and mindfulness sessions. The training provided educators with practical tools and strategies to facilitate open discussions on consent, empowering them to create safer and more inclusive learning environments for their students.

Project Outcomes:

- Continuous Professional Development (CPD) Training for School Educators and Counsellors: 30-hour CPD programme designed for secondary school teachers and counsellors.
- Toolkit of Drama and Storytelling Resources to Talk About Consent: A comprehensive set of materials, including a teacher's handbook, short videos, and tip sheets for students and parents.

Next Steps

- Project partners are finalising implementation activities with teachers, students, and parents.
- A collaborative session will be held to share experiences, insights, and feedback.
- Resources will be refined and adjusted based on the feedback received.
- These final steps will ensure the ACT4CONSENT materials are effective and impactful.
